## Outback Fusion Festival 2 – 3 September 2023

### **EAST PILBARA ARTS CENTRE**

Location: Martumili Gallery Time: 10.00am to 2.00pm

Martumili Artists was established by Martu people living in the communities of Parnpajinya (Newman), Jigalong, Parnngurr, Punmu, Kunawarritji, Irrungadji and Warralong, and it draws on strong influences of aboriginal art history. Based in a purpose-built architecturally designed gallery and studio space, Martumili hosts 4 exhibitions every year, showcasing the unique influence of traditional pujiman desert life of the Artists or their parents and grandparents. Visit Martumili to explore the latest exhibition, Mirrka (Bushfoods), an exhibition showcasing over 80 artworks that explore traditional bushfoods still collected across the Western Desert today.



### **BASKET WEAVING**

Location: Martumili Gallery Time: 10.00am to 1.00pm

Bookings not required, informal creative space. Join Martumili artists in the gallery for a basket weaving circle. Weaving is a skill that has been practiced by Martu for thousands of years, making items such as yakapiri (bark sandals) and manguri (head

pads for balancing carved carrying dishes). Now we see brightly coloured coiled baskets, made with wool puntayarra and minarri grass. Come and sit down with the artists, grab some grass and some wool and see what you can create!
